This funding will be used to

- Increase % of Year 3 and 5 students in U2B for Writing and Number.
- Improve student relative gain from Year 3 to Year 5 to be similar to like schools.
- Increase the percentage of Prep students able to read at or above PM 10.
- 100% of Year 1 students able to read at or above PM 18 and 60% at or above 23.
- 100% of Year 2 students at or above the 60th percentile PAT Reading Booklet 2.
- 60% of Year 2 students at or above the 80th percentile PAT Reading Booklet 2.

Our initiatives include

- Implement Curiosity and Powerful Learning School Improvement Initiative to develop teacher capacity to provide excellent teaching and learning practice, including the use of inquiry approach.
- Build teacher capacity through the provision of mentoring, coaching and establishing collaborative team practices.
- Develop teacher capacity to plan, teach and assess literacy and numeracy.
- Develop teacher capacity to implement digital technology across the curriculum.
- Focused support for oral language development across the school community.
- Additional leadership capacity to support curriculum and pedagogical approaches.

Employ additional teacher aides to decrease staff to student ratio in reading groups and increase student reading comprehension through student engagement in meaningful conversations about texts - Flying Squad	\$ 72 900
Inclusion teacher aide model – increase capacity to cater for cohort and individual student needs	\$ 54 000
Adopt Early Start program to gauge baseline literacy data for Prep students	\$ 4 500



Coaching Year level Data Provide TRS to allow triads of teachers to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations (2 coaching sessions each term and 1 data conversation each term)	\$ 47 150
Speech Pathologist - Employ a speech pathologist to asses Prep and teacher referred students and assist teacher aides, teachers and parents to provide program support for students requiring oral language development	\$ 35 000
0.2 FTE digital coach	\$ 16 638
Coaching for leadership teams - develop capacity of teacher leaders in the school, including SIT, YLC and strategic teams	\$ 25 000
CPL Network - network fees and teacher release for professional development	\$ 16 000
