**Under this agreement for 2020  
Yeronga State School will receive**

**\$271,188\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Prep students able to read at or above PM 10.
- Enable 100% of Year 1 students to read at or above PM 18 and 60% at or above 23.
- Enable 100% of Year 2 students to achieve at or above the 60th percentile PAT Reading Booklet 2.
- Enable 60% of Year 2 students to achieve at or above the 80th percentile PAT Reading Booklet 2.
- Enable 85% of Year 3 students to achieve U2B Reading and 65% U2B Writing.
- Enable 70% Year 5 students to achieve U2B Reading and 50% U2B Writing.
- Improve student relative gain from Year 3 to Year 5 to be similar to like schools.

## Our initiatives include

- Implementing Curiosity and Powerful Learning School Improvement Initiative to develop teacher capacity to provide excellent teaching and learning practice, including the use of inquiry approach.
- Building teacher capacity through the provision of a Writing coach and an Inquiry Coach.
- Developing teacher capacity to plan, teach and assess literacy and numeracy.
- Providing additional leadership capacity to support curriculum and pedagogical approaches.
- Provision of additional personnel support to improve reading outcomes for all students.
- Provision of additional Inclusion personnel support to improve outcomes for students with additional learning needs.
- Supporting U2B students for extension.



## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing additional teacher aides to decrease staff: student ratio in reading groups and increase student reading comprehension through student engagement in meaningful conversations about texts - Flying Squad program.	\$77,000
Coaching Year level data - providing TRS to allow triads of teachers to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits, and professional conversations. Providing Year level teacher release termly for collaborative planning, documentation of units aligned to the Australian Curriculum and engaging in consistent assessment and moderation practices.	\$31,440
Inquiry Coaching - Providing Year level teacher release thrice termly for collaborative Inquiry planning. Inquiry HOC to support teachers engagement with CPL teacher TOA, adopting an inquiry stance and quality instruction.	\$68,000
Expert Feedback Coaching Project - engagement of Dr Cam Brooks (University of Qld) to support teachers engagement with CPL teacher TOA (Assessment for Learning).	\$20,000
Inclusion and Extension Support - U2B students + students with additional learning needs (engagement of Teacher and Teacher Aide).	\$50,000
Leadership Team Coaching and Professional Development (SIT/YLC/Strategic) - develop capacity of teacher leaders in the school.	\$7628
Strategic Planning and Future Trends - data gathering for QSR process.	\$6000
CPL Network - Network fees and teacher release for professional development (with Wayne Craig).	\$11,120
